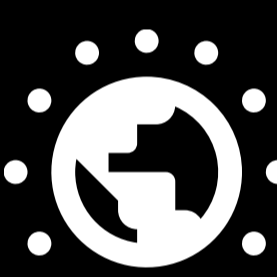
### MIGRATION STUDIES IN LIBYA
